The purpose of a crisis stabilization unit is to stabilize and redirect a client to the most appropriate and 6 7 least restrictive community setting available, consistent with 8 the client's needs. Crisis stabilization units may screen, 9 assess, and admit for stabilization persons who present 10 themselves to the unit and persons who are brought to the unit 11 under s. 394.463.
