The purpose of a crisis stabilization unit is to 7 stabilize and redirect a client to the most appropriate and 8 least restrictive community setting available, consistent with 9 the client's needs. Crisis stabilization units may screen, 10 assess, and admit for stabilization persons who present 11 themselves to the unit and persons who are brought to the unit under s. 394.463. Clients may be provided 24-hour observation, 12 13 medication prescribed by a physician or psychiatrist, and other
