**II. Summary of Amendments Contained in Message:**

**Senate Amendment 1** provides technical conforming changes relating to the Florida Health Choices program. The House refused to concur.

**House Amendment 1** revises the eligibility requirement for the health flex plans by eliminating the requirement that a person must be 64 years of age or younger.

**House Amendment 2** adds licensed orthotists and prosthetists to the current definition of “health care provider,” under s. 766.202, F.S., for purposes of medical malpractice actions pursuant to ch. 766, F.S.
