early voting site. The supervisor shall provide to the division no later than the 30th day before an election the address of each early voting site and the hours that early voting will occur at each site.

(c) All early voting sites in a county shall be open on the same days for the same amount of time and shall allow any person in line at the closing of an early voting site to vote.



(d) Early voting shall begin on the 10th <del>15th</del> day before an election that contains state or federal races and end on the 3rd 2nd day before the an election, and. For purposes of a special election held pursuant to s. 100.101, early voting shall begin on the 8th day before an election and end on the 2nd day before an election. Early voting shall be provided for no less than 6 8 hours and no more than 12 hours per day weekday and 8 hours in the aggregate each weekend at each site during the applicable period, except that counties having 1 million or more registered voters as of the book closing date for the election must provide early voting for 12 hours per day periods. The supervisor of elections may provide early voting for elections that are not held in conjunction with a state or federal election. However, the supervisor has the discretion to determine the hours of operation of early voting sites in those elections. Early voting sites shall open no sooner than 7 a.m. and close no later than 7 p.m. on each applicable day.
