House Joint Resolution 1 2 A joint resolution proposing an amendment to Section 7 of 3 Article IX of the State Constitution to require the 4 Governor to appoint a state university student body 5 president to the Board of Governors of the State 6 University System. 7 8 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Florida: 9 10 That the following amendment to Section 7 of Article IX of 11 the State Constitution is agreed to and shall be submitted to the electors of this state for approval or rejection at the next 12 general election or at an earlier special election specifically 13 14 authorized by law for that purpose: 15 ARTICLE IX 16 SECTION 7. State University System.-17 PURPOSES. In order to achieve excellence through (a) teaching students, advancing research and providing public 18 service for the benefit of Florida's citizens, their communities 19 and economies, the people hereby establish a system of 20 21 governance for the state university system of Florida. 22 (b) STATE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM. There shall be a single 23 state university system comprised of all public universities. A 24 board of trustees shall administer each public university and a 25 board of governors shall govern the state university system. LOCAL BOARDS OF TRUSTEES. Each local constituent 26 (C) 27 university shall be administered by a board of trustees consisting of thirteen members dedicated to the purposes of the 28 Page 1 of 3

29 state university system. The board of governors shall establish 30 the powers and duties of the boards of trustees. Each board of 31 trustees shall consist of six citizen members appointed by the 32 governor and five citizen members appointed by the board of 33 governors. The appointed members shall be confirmed by the 34 senate and serve staggered terms of five years as provided by 35 law. The chair of the faculty senate, or the equivalent, and the 36 president of the student body of the university shall also be 37 members.

38 (d) STATEWIDE BOARD OF GOVERNORS. The board of governors 39 shall be a body corporate consisting of seventeen members. The 40 board shall operate, regulate, control, and be fully responsible 41 for the management of the whole university system. These 42 responsibilities shall include, but not be limited to, defining the distinctive mission of each constituent university and its 43 44 articulation with free public schools and community colleges, ensuring the well-planned coordination and operation of the 45 system, and avoiding wasteful duplication of facilities or 46 47 programs. The board's management shall be subject to the powers of the legislature to appropriate for the expenditure of funds, 48 49 and the board shall account for such expenditures as provided by 50 law. The governor shall appoint to the board fifteen fourteen 51 citizens dedicated to the purposes of the state university 52 system, one of whom shall be a state university student body 53 president. The appointed members shall be confirmed by the 54 senate and serve staggered terms of seven years as provided by 55 law, except that a state university student body president 56 appointed to the board shall serve a term of one year and shall

57 <u>not be subject to senate confirmation</u>. The commissioner of 58 education <u>and</u>, the chair of the advisory council of faculty 59 senates, or the equivalent, and the president of the Florida 60 student association, or the equivalent, shall also be members of 61 the board.

62 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following statement be 63 placed on the ballot:

64 CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT 65 ARTICLE IX, SECTION 7 APPOINTMENT OF STUDENT BODY PRESIDENT TO BOARD OF GOVERNORS 66 67 OF THE STATE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM.-Proposing an amendment to the State Constitution to require that the Governor appoint the 68 student body president of a state university to the Board of 69 70 Governors for a term of 1 year. Specifically, the amendment 71 requires that one of the fifteen citizen members appointed by 72 the Governor be a state university student body president who is 73 not subject to confirmation by the Senate. The amendment removes 74 the president of the Florida Student Association, or the 75 equivalent, as a member of the Board of Governors.
