A bill to be entitled

An act relating to professional practices involving animals; amending ss. 455.2185 and 456.023, F.S.; deleting provisions authorizing certain out-of-state and foreign professionals to engage in professional practices involving animals at certain sporting events; deleting provisions authorizing such professionals to have practice privileges in licensed veterinary and health care facilities; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (2) of section 455.2185, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

455.2185 Exemption for certain out-of-state or foreign professionals; limited practice permitted.—

(2) A professional's practice under this section is limited to the members, coaches, and staff of the team for which that professional is employed or designated and to any animals used if the sporting event for which that professional is employed or designated involves animals. A professional practicing under authority of this section shall not have practice privileges in any licensed veterinary facility without the approval of that facility.

Section 2. Subsection (2) of section 456.023, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

456.023 Exemption for certain out-of-state or foreign professionals; limited practice permitted.—

(2) A professional's practice under this section is limited to the members, coaches, and staff of the team for which that professional is employed or designated and to any animals used if the sporting event for which that professional is employed or designated involves animals. A professional practicing under authority of this section does shall not have practice privileges in any licensed health care facility or veterinary facility without the approval of that facility.

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2011.
