6 (7) (4) In order to assure that consumers have access to 7 different local exchange service providers without being 8 disadvantaged, deterred, or inconvenienced by having to give up 9 the consumer's existing local telephone number, all providers of local exchange services must have access to local telephone numbering resources and assignments on equitable terms that include a recognition of the scarcity of such resources and are 12

in accordance with national assignment guidelines. Each local 13 exchange provider, except small local exchange 14 15 telecommunications companies under rate of return regulation, 16 shall provide a temporary means of achieving telephone number portability. The parties, under the direction of the commission, 17 shall set up a number portability standards group by no later 18 19 than September 1, 1995, for the purposes of investigation and development of appropriate parameters, costs, and standards for 20 number portability. If the parties are unable to successfully 21 negotiate the prices, terms, and conditions of a temporary 22 23 number portability solution, the commission shall establish a 24 temporary number portability solution by no later than January 25 1, 1996. Each local exchange service provider shall make 26 necessary modifications to allow permanent portability of local telephone numbers between certificated providers of local 27 exchange service as soon as reasonably possible after the 28 development of national standards. The parties shall negotiate 29 the prices, terms, and conditions for permanent telephone number 30 31 portability arrangements. In the event the parties are unable to satisfactorily negotiate the prices, terms, and conditions, 32 33 either party may petition the commission and the commission 34 shall, after opportunity for a hearing, set the rates, terms, 35 and conditions. The prices and rates shall not be below cost. Number portability between different certificated providers of 36 37 local exchange service at the same location shall be provided 38 temporarily no later than January 1, 1996. 39 (8) (5) When requested, each certificated telecommunications
