14	failure. Remedial measures to resolve a system failure must be
15	limited to what is necessary to resolve the failure, but must
16	otherwise meet, to the maximum extent practicable, the
17	requirements of the repair code in effect at the time of the
18	repair, provided the exceptions contained in s. 381.0065(4)(g)
19	relating to soil condition, water table elevation, distance, and
20	other setback requirements apply. For purposes of this section,
21	an engineer-designed performance system to reduce nutrients may
22	not be required as an alternative remediation measure to resolve
23	the failure of a conventional system.
