A bill to be entitled

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An act relating to health insurance; prohibiting a person from being compelled to purchase health insurance except under specified conditions; specifying that the act does not prohibit the collection of certain debts; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. Prohibition against requiring the purchase of health insurance; exceptions.—
- (1) A person may not be compelled to purchase health insurance, except as a condition of:
 - (a) Public employment;
 - (b) Voluntary participation in a state or local benefit;
 - (c) Operating a dangerous instrumentality;
- (d) Undertaking an occupation having a risk of occupational injury or illness;
 - (e) An order of child support; or
 - (f) Activity between private persons.
- (2) This section does not prohibit the collection of debts lawfully incurred for health insurance.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
