11	physical rapid heartbeat, vasoconstriction, sweating, euphoria,
12	anxiety, agitation, perception of a diminished requirement for
13	food and sleep, and increases in alertness, awareness,
14	wakefulness, arousal, and blood pressure and
15	WHEREAS, Florida's Attorney General has issued an emergency
16	order banning the sale of substances containing MDVP in the
17	state for a limited period, and
18	WHEREAS, federal action is needed to control MDVP and keep
19	it from entering this state from elsewhere, NOW, THEREFORE,

21	Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

23	That the Congress of the United States is urged to ban the
24	sale, distribution, and possession of methylenedioxypyrovalerone
25	(MDVP).
