An act relating to driver's license examinations; amending s. 322.12, F.S.; providing requirements for examination questions pertaining to traffic regulations relating to blind pedestrians; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (6) is added to section 322.12, Florida Statutes, to read:

322.12 Examination of applicants.-

(6) Each examination given for a Class E driver's license or a commercial driver's license under this section must include one question testing the applicant's knowledge of traffic regulations to assist blind persons. To pass the examination, the applicant must answer that question on the examination correctly. In developing questions under this subsection, the department shall emphasize pedestrian right of way when a driver is making a right turn at an intersection.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2011.
