18	A. Green, M.D., and his colleagues at the University of Miami's

20	Project Medishare established a massive relief effort, and

22	Miami's Global Institute/Project Medishare field hospital opened
23	in Haiti, treating more than 30,000 patients and performing more
24	than 1,500 emergency surgeries, and
25	WHEREAS, more than 5,000 rotating medical volunteers from
26	around the world served at the field hospital, which was the
27	only referral center for severe critical care and trauma cases
28	in Haiti, and
