Paragraph (g) of subsection (5) of section 400.235, Florida Statutes, is redesignated as paragraph (f) and present paragraph (f) of that subsection is amended to read: 400.235 Nursing home quality and licensure status; Gold Seal Program.-(5) Facilities must meet the following additional criteria for recognition as a Gold Seal Program facility: (f) Evidence an outstanding record regarding the number and types of substantiated complaints reported to the State Long-Term Care Ombudsman Council within the 30 months preceding application for the program. A facility assigned a conditional licensure status may not qualify for consideration for the Gold Seal Program until after it has operated for 30 months with no class I or class II deficiencies and has completed a regularly scheduled relicensure survey. Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2011.
