An act relating to a review under the Open Government Sunset Review Act; amending s. 119.071, F.S., which provides an exemption from public-records requirements for biometric identification information held by an agency; saving the exemption from repeal under the Open Government Sunset Review Act; removing the scheduled repeal of the exemption; providing an effective date.

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Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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Section 1. Paragraph (g) of subsection (5) of section 119.071, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

119.071 General exemptions from inspection or copying of public records.—

- (5) OTHER PERSONAL INFORMATION. -
- (g) 1. Biometric identification information held by an agency before, on, or after the effective date of this exemption is exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution. As used in this paragraph, the term "biometric identification information" means:
 - 1.a. Any record of friction ridge detail;
 - 2.b. Fingerprints;
 - 3.c. Palm prints; and
 - 4.d. Footprints.
- 2. This paragraph is subject to the Open Government Sunset
 Review Act in accordance with s. 119.15 and shall stand repealed
 on October 2, 2011, unless reviewed and saved from repeal
