22 <u>(5)(4)</u> It is the intent of this act to encourage and <u>ensure</u> 23 assure cooperation between and among municipalities and counties 24 and to encourage and <u>ensure</u> assure coordination of planning and 25 development activities of units of local government with the 26 planning activities of regional agencies and state government in 27 accord with applicable provisions of law.
