14 utilities, and other electric utilities under its jurisdiction. In resolving territorial disputes, the commission may consider, 15 16 but not be limited to consideration of, the ability of the utilities to expand services within their own capabilities and 17 18 the nature of the area involved, including population, the 19 degree of urbanization of the area, its proximity to other urban 20 areas, and the present and reasonably foreseeable future requirements of the area for other utility services, and the 21 22 data, analysis, and evidence provided by an affected landowner. Any affected landowner that has provided data, analysis, or 23 24 evidence for consideration by the commission in any territorial 25 dispute may file a petition with the commission pursuant to ss. 26 120.569 and 120.57 within 21 days after the decision of the 27 commission.

No provision of this chapter shall be construed or applied to impede, prevent, or prohibit any municipally owned electric utility system from distributing at retail electrical energy within its corporate limits, as such corporate limits exist on July 1, 1974; however, existing territorial agreements shall not be altered or abridged hereby.
