Section 1. This act may be cited as the "Alex Brown Act."
Section 2. Section 316.0075, Florida Statutes, is amended

316.0075 Operator use of commercial mobile radio services
and electronic communications devices
(1) Regulation of operator or passenger use of commercial
mobile radio services and other electronic communications
devices in a motor vehicle is expressly preempted to the state.
(2)(a) A person who has not attained 18 years of age and
is driving or in actual physical control of a motor vehicle on
the roads of this state may not use any type of handheld
cellular telephone or other handheld electronic communications
device.
(b) This subsection does not apply:
1. To a device that is designed for hands-free use and the
person is using it in that manner.
2. When the motor vehicle is stopped and the engine is not
running.
