A bill to be entitled

An act relating to sexual performance by a child; amending s. 827.071, F.S.; defining the term "intentionally view"; prohibiting controlling or intentionally viewing any photograph, motion picture, exhibition, show, image, data, computer depiction, representation, or other presentation that includes sexual conduct by a child; providing an exception; providing penalties; amending s. 921.0022, F.S.; conforming provisions of the offense severity ranking chart of the Criminal Punishment Code to changes made by the act; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsections (1) and (5) of section 827.071, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

827.071 Sexual performance by a child; penalties.-

- (1) As used in this section, the following definitions shall apply:
- (a) "Deviate sexual intercourse" means sexual conduct between persons not married to each other consisting of contact between the penis and the anus, the mouth and the penis, or the mouth and the vulva.
- (b) "Intentionally view" means to deliberately,
 purposefully, and voluntarily view. Proof of intentional viewing
 requires establishing more than a single image, motion picture,
 exhibition, show, image, data, computer depiction,
 representation, or other presentation over any period of time.

(c) (b) "Performance" means any play, motion picture, photograph, or dance or any other visual representation exhibited before an audience.

- (d) (e) "Promote" means to procure, manufacture, issue, sell, give, provide, lend, mail, deliver, transfer, transmute, publish, distribute, circulate, disseminate, present, exhibit, or advertise or to offer or agree to do the same.
- (e) (d) "Sadomasochistic abuse" means flagellation or torture by or upon a person, or the condition of being fettered, bound, or otherwise physically restrained, for the purpose of deriving sexual satisfaction from inflicting harm on another or receiving such harm oneself.
- (f) (e) "Sexual battery" means oral, anal, or vaginal penetration by, or union with, the sexual organ of another or the anal or vaginal penetration of another by any other object; however, "sexual battery" does not include an act done for a bona fide medical purpose.
- $\underline{\text{(g)}}$ "Sexual bestiality" means any sexual act between a person and an animal involving the sex organ of the one and the mouth, anus, or vagina of the other.
- (h) (g) "Sexual conduct" means actual or simulated sexual intercourse, deviate sexual intercourse, sexual bestiality, masturbation, or sadomasochistic abuse; actual lewd exhibition of the genitals; actual physical contact with a person's clothed or unclothed genitals, pubic area, buttocks, or, if such person is a female, breast, with the intent to arouse or gratify the sexual desire of either party; or any act or conduct which constitutes sexual battery or simulates that sexual battery is being or will be committed. A mother's breastfeeding of her baby

does not under any circumstance constitute "sexual conduct."

- (i) (h) "Sexual performance" means any performance or part thereof which includes sexual conduct by a child of less than 18 years of age.
- $\underline{(j)}$ "Simulated" means the explicit depiction of conduct set forth in paragraph $\underline{(h)}$ (g) which creates the appearance of such conduct and which exhibits any uncovered portion of the breasts, genitals, or buttocks.
- (5) (a) It is unlawful for any person to knowingly possess, control, or intentionally view a photograph, motion picture, exhibition, show, representation, image, data, computer depiction, or other presentation which, in whole or in part, he or she knows to include any sexual conduct by a child. The possession, control, or intentional viewing of each such photograph, motion picture, exhibition, show, image, data, computer depiction, representation, or presentation is a separate offense. A person who Whoever violates this subsection commits is guilty of a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.
- (b) This subsection does not apply to material possessed, controlled, or intentionally viewed as part of a law enforcement investigation.
