An act relating to compensation of county officials; amending ss. 145.031, 145.051, 145.071, 145.09, 145.10, and 145.11, F.S.; authorizing each member of a board of county commissioners, each clerk of the circuit court, county comptroller, each sheriff, each supervisor of elections, each property appraiser, and each tax collector to reduce his or her salary on a voluntary basis; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 145.031, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

145.031 Board of county commissioners.-

(1) Each member of the board of county commissioners shall receive as salary the amount indicated, based on the population of his or her county. In addition, compensation shall be made for population increments over the minimum for each population group, which shall be determined by multiplying the population in excess of the minimum for the grouping times the group rate.

In addition, a compensation shall be made for population increments over the minimum for each population group, which shall be determined by multiplying the population in excess of the minimum for the
