Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:

Section 1. Subsection (5) is added to section 401.465, Florida Statutes, to read:

401.465 911 public safety telecommunicator certification.-(5) TEMPORARY 911 PUBLIC SAFETY COMMUNICATORS; EXCEPTION.-Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, a public safety agency may use sworn law enforcement officers as temporary 911 public safety telecommunicators. Any officer who works as a temporary 911 public safety telecommunicator must,
