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A bill to be entitled

An act relating to local government code enforcement boards; amending s. 162.05, F.S.; allowing a local government code enforcement board to adopt requirements that are in lieu of residency standards for members of the board; providing criteria; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (2) of section 162.05, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

(2) Members of the enforcement boards must shall be

residents of the municipality, or in lieu of residency, must meet the requirements adopted by that municipality  $\tau$  in the case of municipal enforcement boards, or must be residents of the county, or in lieu of residency, must meet the requirements adopted by that county in the case of county enforcement boards. The requirements in lieu of residency may include persons who own a business or real property or who work for a business within the boundaries of the municipality or county. Appointments shall be made in accordance with applicable law and ordinances on the basis of experience or interest in the subject matter jurisdiction of the respective code enforcement board, in the sole discretion of the local governing body. The membership of each enforcement board shall, whenever possible, include an architect, a businessperson, an engineer, a general contractor,
