Refund of premium upon termination of policy.-(1) If a life insurance policy, as defined in s. 624.602, Florida Statutes, is deemed to be void, void ab initio, or otherwise terminated or extinguished in accordance with law for any reason, including the lack of an insurable interest as defined in s. 627.404(2), Florida Statutes, except for the nonpayment of premium, the owner of the policy or the owner's designated representative has the right to recover from the insurer all premiums paid on the policy plus any interest on
