Amendment (with title amendment)

Remove everything after the enacting clause and insert: Section 1. Subsection (4) of section 1001.03, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

1001.03 Specific powers of State Board of Education.-

(4) PROFESSIONAL TEACHER ASSOCIATIONS.-

The State Board of Education shall ensure that not-(a) for-profit, professional teacher associations that offer membership to all teachers, noninstructional personnel, and 13 administrators, and that offer teacher training and staff 14 development at no fee to the district, shall be given equal access to initial orientations and voluntary teacher meetings, 15 be provided access to teacher mailboxes for distribution of 16 17 professional literature, and be authorized to collect voluntary 18 membership fees through payroll deduction.

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19	(b) A not-for-profit, professional teacher association
20	described in paragraph (a) is not an employee organization for
21	purposes of part II of chapter 447 until it applies for
22	registration as a certified bargaining agent for public
