Section 1. Paragraph (q) is added to subsection (9) of section 1002.33, Florida Statutes, to read:

1002.33 Charter schools.-

- (9) CHARTER SCHOOL REQUIREMENTS.-
- (q) A charter school shall maintain an Internet website through which parents of students and the public can obtain information about the school, its personnel, and its programs. The website shall include a link that is clearly visible near the top of the page through which visitors to the website can obtain information about any agency that owns or manages the school, including whether it's a nonprofit or for-profit entity. The information must include the names of all governing officers and administrative personnel of an agency that owns or manages the school and any fees the school pays to the agency.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2012.
