A bill to be entitled 1 2 An act relating to a review under the Open Government 3 Sunset Review Act; amending s. 624.23, F.S., which 4 provides a public records exemption for certain 5 records relating to consumer complaints and inquiries 6 regarding matters or activities regulated under the 7 Florida Insurance Code or the Employee Assistance and 8 Ombudsman Office within the Department of Financial 9 Services; reorganizing the definition of "consumer"; 10 providing exceptions to the exemption; eliminating the 11 scheduled repeal of the exemption under the Open 12 Government Sunset Review Act; providing an effective 13 date.

15 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida: 16

Section 1. Section 624.23, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

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624.23 Public records exemption.-

(1) As used in this section, the term:

(a) "Consumer" means:

1. A prospective purchaser, purchaser, or beneficiary of, or applicant for, any product or service regulated under the Florida Insurance Code, and a family member or dependent of a consumer.

(2) Personal financial and health information held by the 47 48 department or office relating to a consumer's complaint or 49 inquiry regarding a matter or activity regulated under the 50 Florida Insurance Code or s. 440.191 are confidential and exempt 51 from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State 52 Constitution. This exemption applies to personal financial and 53 health information held by the department or office before, on, 54 or after the effective date of this exemption.

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(a) Another governmental entity, if disclosure is necessary
for the receiving entity to perform its duties and

of the consumer or the consumer's legally authorized
representative.
(4) This section is subject to the Open Government Sunset
Review Act in accordance with s. 119.15 and shall stand repealed
on October 2, 2012, unless reviewed and saved from repeal
through reenactment by the Legislature.
Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2012.
