Section 16. Section 196.061, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

7 196.061 Rental of homestead to constitute abandonment.-The 8 rental of <u>all or substantially all of a</u> an entire dwelling 9 previously claimed to be a homestead for tax purposes shall 10 constitute the abandonment of <u>such said</u> dwelling as a homestead, 11 and <u>the said</u> abandonment shall continue until such dwelling is 12 physically occupied by the owner thereof. 13 abandonment of such homestead after January 1 of any year does 14 shall not affect the homestead exemption for tax purposes for 15 that particular year if so long as this provision is not used for 2 consecutive years. The provisions of this section do shall 16 17 not apply to a member of the Armed Forces of the United States whose service in such forces is the result of a mandatory 18 19 obligation imposed by the federal Selective Service Act or who volunteers for service as a member of the Armed Forces of the 20 21 United States. Moreover, valid military orders transferring such 22 member are shall be sufficient to maintain permanent residence, 23 for the purpose of s. 196.015, for the member and his or her 24 spouse. 25 26 And the title is amended as follows: 27 Delete line 68 28 29 and insert: results in the lowest taxable value of a homestead; 30 amending s. 196.061, F.S.; clarifying provisions
