Section 18. For purposes of clarification of Legislative intent, section 4 of chapter 2009-244, Laws of Florida, is amended to read:

Section 4. (1) This award, appropriated up to a grand total of \$9.5 million, is intended to provide the sole compensation for all present and future claims arising out of the factual situation described in this act which resulted in the injury to Jorge and Debbie Garcia-Bengochea and their adopted sons, Brian, Matthew, and James Garcia-Bengochea.



(2) The total amount paid for attorney attorney's fees and lobbying fees are to be paid exclusively to the attorneys and lobbyists currently retained by the claimants and registered pursuant to s. 11.045, Florida Statutes, and no other attorneys and lobbyists. The total amount paid for attorney's fees, lobbying fees, costs, and other similar expenses relating to this claim may not exceed 25 percent of each annual payment awarded pursuant to this act. Further, no more than 25 percent of each annual payment may be used to pay attorney's fees, lobbying fees, costs, and other similar expenses relating to this claim.

Section 19. The provisions of section 18 of this act are remedial.
