Between lines 287 and 288 insert:

Section 5. (1) It is unlawful for any person to artificially dye or color any rabbit or fowl, including, but not limited to, rabbits, baby chickens, and ducklings, or to bring any dyed or colored rabbit or fowl into this state.

- (2) It is unlawful for any person to sell, offer for sale, or give away as merchandising premiums, baby chickens, ducklings, or other fowl under 4 weeks of age or rabbits under 2 months of age to be used as pets, toys, or retail premiums.
 - (3) This section does not apply to any animal or fowl,



including, but not limited to, rabbits, baby chickens, and ducklings to be used or raised for agricultural purposes by persons who have proper facilities to care for them or for poultry or livestock exhibitions. This section also does not apply to dogs or cats.

(4) Any person who violates this section, upon conviction, is guilty of a misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083, Florida Statutes.
