HB 1407 2012

A bill to be entitled

An act relating to scuba diver fishing licenses; amending s. 379.354, F.S.; provides that an individual diver is not required to hold a fishing license while on a vessel for hire if the vessel operator maintains the appropriate license and permits; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (f) is added to subsection (7) of section 379.354, Florida Statutes, to read:

379.354 Recreational licenses, permits, and authorization numbers; fees established.—

- (7) VESSEL LICENSES.—
- (f) If the operator of a vessel that carries scuba divers for a fee, either directly or indirectly, maintains the appropriate vessel license under this subsection based upon the number of persons the vessel is licensed to carry and any applicable permits, the individual scuba divers engaged in taking or attempting to take saltwater products are not required to obtain individual fishing licenses and permits. However, if such vessel operator does not have the appropriate license, the scuba divers engaged in taking or attempting to take saltwater products must have individual fishing licenses and any applicable permits.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2012.
