2 A memorial to the Congress of the United States, 3 urging Congress to stop the increase to the federal 4 loan guarantee program for new nuclear reactors and 5 rescind the remaining funds, eliminate the funding for 6 mixed oxide plutonium fuel plants, support energy 7 efficiency and renewable sources of energy and fund 8 nuclear waste immobilization, increase funding for 9 environmental cleanup programs, and direct the United 10 States Department of Energy to comply with all cleanup 11 agreements and legacy management requirements. 12 WHEREAS, the President of the United States and the United 13 14 States Congress have taken the positive step of ending all 15 funding for the Yucca Mountain nuclear repository site, which 16 has already cost taxpayers \$96.2 billion, in an effort to provide taxpayers relief and protect our environment, and 17 WHEREAS, taxpayer dollars are being spent to fund the 18 19 construction of mixed oxide plutonium fuel plants which will 20 only exacerbate the environmental degradation of the areas 21 surrounding the sites, and 22 WHEREAS, investing in cheaper, faster, cleaner, and safer 23 renewable energy alternatives other than nuclear power and 24 immobilizing nuclear waste should be our foremost economic and 25 national security priority, and 26 WHEREAS, sufficient funding for environmental cleanup is 27 necessary to ensure compliance with cleanup agreements and
