Section 1. Subsections (6) and (9) of section 943.68,
Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

(6) <u>(a)</u> The department shall provide security or
transportation services to other persons when requested by the
Governor, the Lieutenant Governor, a member of the Cabinet, the
Speaker of the House of Representatives, the President of the
Senate, or the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court, subject to
certification by the requesting party that such services are in
the best interest of the state. The requesting party may
delegate certification authority to the executive director of
the department. The requesting party shall limit such services
to persons:
1(a) Who are visiting the state; for whom such services
are requested by the Governor, the Lieutenant Governor, a member
of the Cabinet, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the
President of the Senate, or the Chief Justice of the Supreme
Court; and for whom the primary purpose of the visit is for a

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30 <u>2.(b)</u> For whom the failure to provide security or 31 transportation could result in a clear and present danger to the 32 personal safety of such persons or to the safety of other 33 persons or property within this state or could result in public 34 embarrassment to the state.

35 (b) The department shall request payment from the person 36 or entity represented by the person receiving services under 37 subparagraph (a)1. for the cost of such services.

38 The department shall submit a report each July 15 to (9) 39 the Governor, the Legislature, and the Cabinet, detailing all 40 transportation and protective services provided under subsections (1), (5), and (6) within the preceding fiscal year. 41 42 Each report shall include a detailed accounting of the cost of such transportation and protective services, including the names 43 44 of persons provided such services, and the nature of state 45 business performed, and payments received for services provided 46 under subparagraph (6)(a)1.

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Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2012.

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
