This exemption applies 32 to electronic mail addresses or physical addresses, and any 33 information related to such electronic mail addresses or 34 physical addresses, held by an agency before, on, or after the 35 effective date of this exemption. 36 (b) Paragraph (a) is subject to the Open Government Sunset Review Act in accordance with s. 119.15 and shall stand repealed 37 on October 2, 2017, unless reviewed and saved from repeal 38 39 through reenactment by the Legislature. 40 Section 2. The Legislature finds that is a public 41 necessity that an electronic mail address or physical address, 42 and any information related to such electronic mail address or 43 physical address, furnished to the Department of Law Enforcement 44 by persons other than sexual predators or offenders, as defined 45 under s. 775.21, s. 943.0435, s. 944.606, s. 944.607, s. 46 985.4815, or s. 985.481, Florida Statutes, when requesting 47 access to the system which provides automatic notification of 48 registration information regarding sexual predators and 49 offenders as authorized by s. 943.44353, Florida Statutes, be 50 held exempt from s. 119.07(1), Florida Statutes, and s. 24(a), 51 Art. I of the State Constitution. By alleviating concerns about 52 disclosure of information that could be used for criminal 53 purposes, the public records exemption for such addresses and information significantly enhances public safety by encouraging 54 55 greater participation in and use of the Department of Law 56 Enforcement's notification system.
