Between lines 1160 and 1161 insert:

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(17) REFERRAL FEES.—A person, entity, or licensee may not accept a fee for the referral of the insured to a person, entity, or licensee for medical benefits under paragraph (1)(a) unless the person, entity, or licensee making the referral discloses in writing to the insured and the insurer that he or she has received a referral fee, the amount of the referral fee, and the name and business address of the person or entity that provided the referral fee.
