Senate Amendment

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Between lines 389 and 390 insert:

- 8. Providing appropriate infrastructure, equipment, and staffing levels to adequately support and provide meaningful customer service, including, but not limited to, toll-free telephone lines.
- 9. Developing guidelines and standards for, and requirements for each circuit to submit, a detailed county-bycounty plan, which sets out county-specific procedures for identifying and assisting, during the application process, persons who have disabilities, who are illiterate or have limited proficiency in English, who are homeless, who are



homebound, who live in remote areas, who are without free access
to technology, or who are frail or elderly. The plans must be
approved by department headquarters and updated annually. The
plans shall be publicized on the Internet and through flyers,
posters, and other media in low-income communities.
