30	salary payment, less applicable state and federal taxes, which
31	would otherwise be paid to the person elected to the state,
32	county, municipal, or special district office when that person
33	owes a fine to the Commission on Ethics or the Florida Elections
34	Commission. The salary payment withheld shall be remitted to the
35	commission that is owed the fine until the fine is satisfied.
36	(3) The Chief Financial Officer or the governing body of a
