A bill to be entitled

An act relating to trust funds; creating s. 551.317,

F.S.; creating the Destination Resort Trust Fund

within the Department of Gaming Control; providing for the purpose of the trust fund; providing for future

review and termination or re-creation of the trust fund; providing a contingent effective date.

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Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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Section 1. Section 551.317, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

551.317 Destination Resort Trust Fund.—

- (1) The Destination Resort Trust Fund is created within the Department of Gaming Control.
- (2) The trust fund is established for the deposit of licensing fees of destination resorts and the proceeds of gross receipts taxes imposed on destination resorts. Funds may be expended only pursuant to legislative appropriation or an approved amendment to the Department of Gaming Control's operating budget pursuant to chapter 216, Florida Statutes.
- (3) In accordance with s. 19(f)(2), Art. III of the State Constitution, the trust fund shall, unless terminated sooner, be terminated on July 1, 2016. Before its scheduled termination, the trust fund shall be reviewed as provided in s. 215.3206(1) and (2).
- Section 2. This act shall take effect on the same date that HB 487 or similar legislation takes effect, if such

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legislation is enacted in the same legislative session, or an extension thereof, and becomes law, and only if this act is enacted by a three-fifths vote of the membership of each house of the Legislature.

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
