Lighters and matches must be located by a retailer so 38 (b) as to limit direct access to them by a customer before purchase. 39 40 (c) Each retailer selling lighters or matches must post a 41 sign stating, "The sale of lighters and matches to a person 42 under the age of 18 is prohibited."
