16 plate as provided in this section. The plate must bear the 17 colors and design approved by the department and must 18 incorporate the official American Legion emblem adopted in 1919. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate and the 19 words "American Legion" must appear at the bottom of the plate. 20 21 (b) Proceeds from the annual use fees shall be distributed 22 to the American Legion, Department of Florida, which shall 23 retain all revenues from the sale of the plates until all 24 startup costs for developing and issuing the plates have been 25 recovered.
