## 871.015 Unlawful protests.—

(1) As used in this section, the term "other protest activities" means any actions that are disruptive or undertaken to disrupt or disturb a funeral, burial, or memorial service.

(2) A person may not knowingly picket or engage in other

protest activities, and a person may not knowingly cause picketing or other protest activities to occur, within 500 feet of the property line of any residence, cemetery, funeral home, house of worship, or other location during or within 1 hour before or 1 hour after the conducting of a funeral, burial, or memorial service at that place for any military service member,
