A bill to be entitled

An act for the relief of Laura Strazza Phillips; providing an appropriation to compensate her for injuries she sustained as a result of the negligence of an employee of the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services; providing a limitation on the payment of fees and costs; providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, on April 25, 1996, Laura Strazza, n/k/a Laura Strazza Phillips, was riding as a passenger in a motor vehicle

on U.S. 1 in Juno Beach, Palm Beach County, and

WHEREAS, an employee of the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, Division of Forestry, was operating, on and next to that highway, a large transport truck that collided with the motor vehicle in which Laura Strazza Phillips was a passenger, and

WHEREAS, as a consequence of this motor vehicle crash,
Laura Strazza Phillips sustained multiple grievous injuries such
that she has been unable to work, has undergone surgical
procedures, and needs to undergo future surgical procedures, and

WHEREAS, a legal action was brought by Laura Strazza Phillips against the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, and

WHEREAS, on July 13, 1999, a jury rendered a verdict in favor of Laura Strazza Phillips finding that the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services was partly negligent in causing a motor vehicle crash between the vehicle in which Mrs. Phillips was riding as a passenger and the department's

transport truck, and

WHEREAS, the jury rendered damages in the amount of \$1,464,000, and, after reduction for collateral sources and comparative negligence of the driver of the vehicle in which Laura Strazza Phillips was riding, a Final Judgment in the amount of \$944,829 and a Cost Judgment in the amount of \$32,490.62, both bearing interest at the statutory rate of 10 percent per year, were entered against the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, and

WHEREAS, the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services has paid Laura Strazza Phillips \$100,000, the maximum amount allowable under s. 768.28, Florida Statutes, and the remainder owed under the judgment is \$877,319.62, plus \$5,002.60 in additional costs, for a total amount of \$882,322.22, NOW, THEREFORE,

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. The facts stated in the preamble to this act are found and declared to be true.

Section 2. The sum of \$882,322.22 is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services for the relief of Laura Strazza Phillips for injuries and damages sustained.

Section 3. The Chief Financial Officer is directed to draw a warrant in favor of Laura Strazza Phillips in the amount of \$882,322.22 upon funds of the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services in the State Treasury, and the Chief Financial Officer is directed to pay the same out of such funds in the

Section 4. The amount paid by the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services pursuant to s. 768.28, Florida Statutes, and the amount paid pursuant to this act are intended to provide the sole compensation for all present and future claims arising out of the factual situation described in this act which resulted in injuries to Laura Strazza Phillips. The total amount paid for attorney's fees, lobbying fees, costs, and other similar expenses relating to this claim may not exceed 25 percent of the amount awarded under this act.

Section 5. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
