14 cause the barrier removal not to be readily achievable. If compliance would cause the barrier removal not to be readily 15 16 achievable, a facility may provide parking spaces at alternative locations for persons who have disabilities and provide 17 18 appropriate signage directing such persons to the alternative parking if readily achievable. The facility may not reduce the 19 20 required number or dimensions of those spaces or unreasonably increase the length of the accessible route from a parking space 21 22 to the facility. The removal of an architectural barrier must 23 not create a significant risk to the health or safety of a 24 person who has a disability or to others.

25 2. A facility that is making alterations under s. 553.507(2) (b) must comply with this section to the maximum 26 27 extent feasible. If compliance with parking location requirements is not feasible, the facility may provide parking 28 spaces at alternative locations for persons who have 29 30 disabilities and provide appropriate signage directing such persons to alternative parking. The facility may not reduce the 31 32 required number or dimensions of those spaces, or unnecessarily 33 increase the length of the accessible route from a parking space 34 to the facility. The alteration must not create a significant 35 risk to the health or safety of a person who has a disability or 36 to others.
