At the end of existing proviso language, immediately following Specific Appropriation 1272, INSERT:

From the funds in Specific Appropriation 1272, \$1,400,000 in recurring general revenue funds is provided to the Department of Juvenile Justice to fund the expansion of CINS/FINS services to provide for early intervention to youth who are experiencing in school disciplinary referrals. Youth will participate in a web-based behavioral intervention and skills development curriculum that is tied to problem behaviors as well as mentoring and counseling services for those youth in need of additional intervention.

Line item amendments are accepted as part of the amendatory process. However, due to the necessity of using computerized systems this may entail a different placement within a budget entity or the renumbering of the specific appropriation items.
