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13 (2) DEFINITIONS.-As used in this section, the term: (a) "Behavioral health services" means mental health 14 15 services and substance abuse prevention and treatment services as defined in this chapter and chapter 397 which are provided 16 17 using state and federal funds. (b) "Decisionmaking model" means a comprehensive management 18 19 information system needed to answer the following management questions at the federal, state, regional, circuit, and local 20 21 provider levels: who receives what services from which providers 22 with what outcomes and at what costs? 23 (c) "Geographic area" means a county, circuit, regional, or 24 multiregional area in this state. 25 (d) "Managing entity" means a corporation that is organized 26 in this state, is designated or filed as a nonprofit organization under s. 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, 27 28 and is under contract to the department to manage the day-to-day 29 operational delivery of behavioral health services through an organized system of care. 30 31 32 33 And the title is amended as follows: 34 Delete lines 3 - 7 35 and insert: 36 37 services; amending s. 394.9082, F.S.; redefining the term 38 "provider networks";
