837.05 False reports to law enforcement authorities.-

(1) Except as provided in subsection (2), <u>a person who</u> whoever knowingly gives false information to <u>a</u> any law enforcement officer concerning the alleged commission of any crime, commits:

14 <u>(a) For a first offense resulting in conviction,</u> a 15 misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as provided in s. 16 775.082 or s. 775.083.

17 (b) For a second or subsequent offense resulting in 18 conviction, a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided 19 in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.
