Section 1. Section 1009.213, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

1009.213 Nonresident tuition exemption.-

- (1) Beginning with the 2012 fall term, a student, other than a nonimmigrant alien within the meaning of 8 U.S.C. s.

 1101(a)(15), is exempt from paying nonresident tuition at a state university or a Florida College System institution if the student meets all of the following requirements:
- (a) Attended high school in the state for 3 or more years, which need not be consecutive.
- (b) Graduated from a high school in the state or attained a high school equivalency diploma pursuant to s. 1003.435.
- (c) Registered as an entering student or is currently enrolled at a state university or a Florida College System institution.
 - (d) In the case of a student without lawful immigration
