An act relating to elected officials; requiring that the Commission on Ethics and the Florida Elections Commission notify the Chief Financial Officer or the governing body of a county, municipality, or special district of any unpaid fines levied against a person who has been elected to a state, county, municipal, or special district office; requiring that the Chief Financial Officer or the governing body of a county, municipality, or special district withhold salary payments that would otherwise be paid to an elected official when that official owes a fine to the Commission on Ethics or the Florida Elections Commission; authorizing the Chief Financial Officer or the governing body to retain a percentage of the payment for administrative costs; providing an effective date.

Section 1. Payment of unpaid fines by elected officials.-

- (1) The Commission on Ethics and the Florida Elections

 Commission shall notify the Chief Financial Officer or the

 governing body of a county, municipality, or special district of

 any fine owed to the Commission on Ethics or the Florida

 Elections Commission by a person who has been elected to a

 state, county, municipal, or special district office.
 - (2) The Chief Financial Officer or the governing body of a

county, municipality, or special district shall withhold any
salary payment, less applicable state and federal taxes, which
would otherwise be paid to the person elected to the state,
county, municipal, or special district office when that person
owes a fine to the Commission on Ethics or the Florida Elections
Commission. The salary payment withheld shall be remitted to the
commission that is owed the fine until the fine is satisfied.

(3) The Chief Financial Officer or the governing body of a county, municipality, or special district may retain up to 2 percent of each payment made in order to cover the administrative costs incurred under this section.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2012.
