6 Remove lines 99-114 and insert:

7 (q) Those persons exempted by commission permit issued
8 under this paragraph. The commission may issue a permit for an
9 outdoor recreational event for which the primary purpose is the
10 rehabilitation or enjoyment of veterans certified by the United
11 States Department of Veterans Affairs or its predecessor or by
12 any branch of the United States Armed Forces to have any
13 service-connected disability percentage rating of zero percent
14 or higher, active duty service members of any branch of the
15 United States Armed Forces, the United States Coast Guard,
16 military reserves, the Florida National Guard, or the United
17 States Coast Guard Reserve. A permit issued under this paragraph
18 shall exempt such veterans, service members, their immediate
19 family members and one additional person designated to assist
20 each veteran certified to be a disabled veteran, from having to



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21 possess a hunting, freshwater fishing, or saltwater fishing
22 license for the duration of the event. For purposes of this
23 exemption, immediate family members means parents, spouses, and
24 children. The commission shall promulgate rules to implement
25 this paragraph. Factors for the commission to consider in
26 determining to issue a permit under this paragraph include but
27 are not limited to: hunting and fishing seasons, time frame or
28 duration of the event, species concerns, and the number of such
29 permits granted to the organizer of the event during the
30 calendar year the permit is requested.
