An act relating to tax deeds; amending s. 197.502, F.S.; authorizing the tax collector to charge for reimbursement of the costs for providing online tax deed application services; providing that an applicant's use of such online application services is optional under certain circumstances; providing an effective date.

10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (1) of section 197.502, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

14 197.502 Application for obtaining tax deed by holder of tax 15 sale certificate; fees.-

(1) The holder of a tax certificate at any time after 2 16 17 years have elapsed since April 1 of the year of issuance of the tax certificate and before the cancellation of the certificate, 18 19 may file the certificate and an application for a tax deed with 20 the tax collector of the county where the property described in 21 the certificate is located. The tax collector may charge a tax 2.2 deed application fee of \$75 and for reimbursement of the costs 23 for providing online tax deed application services. If the tax 24 collector charges a combined fee in excess of \$75, applicants 25 shall have the option of using the electronic tax deed 26 application process or filing applications without using such
