emergency service organization. which exists primarily for the benefit of veterans or their families when:

- (a) No such organization has registered with the department as required under s. 496.405; or
- (b) Having registered, did not describe in their registration statement a manner of applying fifty-one percent or more of its contributions to benefit veterans or their families including a general description of the benefit provided to veterans and their families; or
- (c) Having registered and having described in their registration statement a manner of applying fifty-one percent or more of its contributions to benefit veteran's or their families including a general description of the benefit to veterans and their families, fail to apply the contributions received in a manner consistent with description in their registration statement.

For purposes of this subsection, to solicit contributions from another person or organization while wearing the uniform, regardless of whether rank insignia is displayed, of a member of the United States Air Force, United States Army, United States Coast Guard, United States Marine Corps, United States Navy, the National Guard, if such person is not, or has never been entitled to wear such uniform either through enlistment or commission in any branch of the United States Armed Forces, with the intent to deceive persons that he or she is a member of or represents a veteran's charitable organization or sponsor, constitutes a false statement.
