Section 1. Subsections (5) through (9) of section 847.012, Florida Statutes, are renumbered as subsections (6) through (10), respectively, and a new subsection (5) is added to that section to read:

847.012 Harmful materials; sale or distribution to minors or using minors in production prohibited; penalty.—

(5) An adult may not knowingly distribute to a minor on school property, or post on school property, any material described in subsection (3). As used in this subsection, the term "school property" means the grounds or facility of any kindergarten, elementary school, middle school, junior high school, or secondary school, whether public or nonpublic. This subsection does not apply to the distribution or posting of
